Convene

Round Table

Southern Star – The new pipeline was discussed and that it is a proactive approach to maintenance.

Health Department – They have been busy with school immunizations and are preparing for flu season.

Rural Fire – The department is getting closer to having the Welda Fire Station built. Fire calls have been down due to the weather. The recent storms have kept the department busy with clean up and emergency management.

EMS – The hospital has water standing on the north side of the parking lot and they are getting it fixed. The EMS department has been working on getting programs approved so that they can move forward with training.

Ethanol Plant – The renewal plant will hopefully be up and running by the end of the year. John retired in August and his duties have been distributed between staff members.

KDEM – Steve Harshaw talked about the disaster declarations from the flooding this past year. The state has received 70 county declarations that they are currently working on for funding. The NWS predicts the same weather pattern through the fall and possibly the first frost.

Beachner Grain – They are putting in ammonia hydras storage at their facility.

Anderson County Commission – The County has finished blacktopping Bush City road and will be stripped soon. The courthouse project will be wrapped up in October.

Emergency Management – JD has been reporting spilled or leaked hazardous material to the State during incidents. He has reported two (a KCP&L transformer and Rural Fire generator) due to weather.
