- antifreeze
- lighter fluid
- kerosene
- paint thinner
- aerosol containers
- oil or enamel-based paint
- bug spray
- pesticides/herbicides
- drain cleaner
- oven cleaner
- toilet, tub or tile cleaner
- bleach
- rust remover
- battery acids
- pool acids or chemicals
- peroxides
- mercury thermometers
